Our mission

PFT's mission is to sustain America's forests for their public benefits of wood, water, wildlife, and people's well-being, in cooperation with landowners and communities.

How we do it

- We have led the conservation of more than 265,000 acres of vital working forests in Washington, Oregon, and California, and we steward more than 100,000 acres through permanent Working Forest Conservation Easements (WFCEs). WFCEs protect the land in perpetuity—if landowners sell their land, those forests are still protected by the WFCE.
- We pioneer new policy initiatives that reward landowners for managing
 for multiple forest benefits. We have successfully passed state laws and
 shaped regional and national forest conservation and climate policies to
 save wildlife and their habitats, create effective climate change solutions,
 conserve intact forested landscapes, and protect our water sources.
